#### 5. Green Bay Area RoomTax Monthly Summary Tax Collection Report

##### a. Green Bay Area Room Tax Collections from June, July and August, 2017

Pamela Manley reported on the June, July and August Room Tax summary tax collection report. August was the first time they received AirBNB payments. That was \$10,749.17 for Green Bay, higher than what was predicted. It is up from last year. Pamela said the report from AirBNB is vague for details. Jason Hager said this is a start. The demand is lower at hotels in 2017.

#### 6. Village of Ashwauenon Short Term Rental Housing Update

##### a. Ordinance No. O10-3-17- Licensing of Short Term Rentals

Allison Swanson gave an update on the Village of Ashwaubenon Short Term Rentals. The new laws adopted mandate the lodging market places have to collect room tax and the law also prohibits municipalities from prohibiting short term rentals. The Village of Ashwaubenon is the only municipality that was prohibiting them (they had an area designated). The village has since eliminated their ordinance and the Conditional Use process on STR. The licensing only kicks in if they rent 10-nights or more. These are a few of the things the village have changed or are working on:

- Adopted ordinance with licensing provision - \$500 annual licensing fee, renewal each year. It requires them to have a property manager within 25 miles of the

- property.
- They will get Village inspections, Health Department inspections; licensing and do background checks on them.
- They have a packet they hand out to those applying for Short Term Rentals. It will include application, rules and current Room Tax collection form.
- Trying to find new agency to find rentals.
- Bukowski would like the Ashwaubenon to add to ordinance - to whom they are renting to, how much and how long

## 7. Update on Collaborative Room Tax Collection

Jason Hager stated that he wanted to commend Allison and the Village of Ashwaubenon on trying to pull everyone/everything together. In September there was a collaborative meeting - health department, municipalities and finance. The meeting was to get everyone on the same page - awareness of what needs to be done. Swanson said that now that everyone has to report, there should be more report consistency as to what is out there, what is being submitted and how to reconcile what is out there.

Discussion was held on the draft Room Tax form. The form consists of facility, owner and preparer name and address information, room sales information; tax exempt guest information, short term rental information and tax exempt guest information for short term rentals. Collections should be consistent. Bukowski stated that the collection of Room Tax is to pay the bonds / CVB. Someone should be able to monitor and reconcile. Swanson said that not all municipalities have an ordinance in place to collect room taxes. Brad Toll stated that it's a shared economy; the CVB needs to figure out how to work with it. Should review in a few months to see where we are at, and see if the municipalities know what should be reported. The Room Tax committee agreed with the draft Room Tax form. It was agreed to have two separate forms - one for Short term rentals and one for hotels.

**Motion (Bukowski, Olejniczak) to compose** a joint letter from CVB and Room Tax commission (Jason Hager to sign) to go to certain municipalities (Town of Scott, Village of Hobart, Village of Ledgeview, Village of Lawrence), to explain what we want to accomplish and why it's important - CVB funding.

## 9. CVB Report - Brad Toll

CVB Update: Brad Toll handed out the Star Report, occupancy and Revenue is up. YTD demand is 4.2% and supply is 3.7%. Hotel Northland possibly opening in 2018 (July) and Home 2 Suites - December 2017 opening. Hotels hoping for rate growth in 2018. Brown County Arena - BC is in budget right now. There is a Memorandum of Understanding and they have prepared a draft RFP on the arena. CVB is developing a cabinet for fund raising. Expand to surrounding

areas, trying to sell to corporate communities and sharing the character of the community. KI Center is doing well. Tiletown District has great reviews!
