6. CVB Update / Recap 2017 and 2018 Plan - Brad Toll

Brad Toll (President of VCB) presented to the Room Tax Commission the 2017 recap and 2018 Plan. Toll handed out the 2018 Destination Marketing, Sales and Services Plan for the Greater

Green Bay Convention and Visitors Bureau. He also handed out the 2018 Visitor Guide.

Bukowski asked about the ½% sales tax and if this should be on next agenda. Jeff Flynt (BC) stated that they are challenging the county's interpretation of what the statute says. The statute says it has to go directly to reduce property taxes-dollar for dollar. There's an Attorney General's opinion (which is 20-yrs old) that says anything that normally would raise property tax levy, it can go to pay for that in addition to direct dollar for dollar.

7. Short Term Rental Update - Swanson

Jason Hager stated that the Room Tax Commission has been talking about short term rentals for a while. The biggest discussion was on how this was being monitored and how was this being identified as short term housing. The Village of Ashwaubenon and the City of Green Bay has done a great job with handling that. Ashwaubenon was using a company called BNB Shield, but they are no longer in business. Ashwaubenon has been looking for a new group. A sub group to this committee was given a presentation from a company called STR Helper. This company says it can do the following: scan for all short term rentals in the Brown County area: inclusive of all municipalities. Then will report back where all short term rentals are. It is supposed to be as detailed as to which houses turn off/on and what site they are on. There is identity and enforcement to be done on these homes. Tony Wachewicz stated that the best thing is their ability to identify and generate all that information. Other options is to get a licensing ordinance, it can be built into the program. Each municipality has to tailor it to what works for them. There is a basic level for \$8,500 (just identification) and an advanced level for \$10,500 (take complaints from public, licensing, compliance, tax component). This is an annual price. Wachewicz also stated that he understands from the approved Room Tax agreements that there is funding available, and the municipalities don't have to kick in. The money would come out of the room tax funds. Hopefully the municipalities would be able to generate enough Room Tax to cover this. The Village of Ashwaubenon is doing reference checks on this company.

Matt Harris said he was at the meeting and he thinks this sounds like a great program, even if they only try it for a year.

Bruce Wolf asked how the funding worked, what percentage would come from each municipality. Thought it would be a great idea for all the municipalities to adopt the same rules and procedures. Wachewicz stated it wasn't discussed but he believes it will come from a pool of funds coming in. It was talked about if the commission wants to go along with this that there is an signed agreement with Brown County, each municipality and the Room Tax Commission and they also sign with this company. After that it will be determined how the pricing would be for each municipality. Wendy Townsend stated that it should be a fair distribution. Discussion was held on where this fund came from.

Motion to give Jason Hager the authority to review the agreement on file in regards with the expenditures of the funds discussed (\$60,000). What does it require, in terms of ability to expend those funds and if it does not require municipal approval to hire STR (\$10,500 for one year). If it does need municipality approval, the Room Tax committee members should bring back to their municipalities for approval.
