**A. Park & Recreation - Rex**

Mehlberg stated:

- McCarthy Way has reopened with sidewalks on the north side, at the hotels, noting there are two (2) more hotels coming in that area near The Bar.
- Per the Brown County Planning Commission, the County is planning on moving forward with the extension of the Packerland Trail from Fernando to Grant St.
- The trail on Grant St. extension from Sand Acres to Packerland Drive will be looked at in the future.
- Sidewalks will be included in the 2019 Waube connection project.
- Cormier roadway reconstruction will include sidewalks in the missing areas of the south side of the street.
- Soil boring is being done at the old Schneider property; results will determine type of potential housing to be constructed; trail to be incorporated as appropriate.
- Walk to School Day is Wednesday, October 10th; free swim passes for the pool will be handed out to all walkers.
